A note about report cards ...

On Friday, March 27th you will receive your child's report card for second term. Here are a few points of interest regarding these reports:

- This will be the first Kindergarten report card to include specific levels of achievement (the first report was anecdotal only)
- SA refers to *Strong Achievement* ~ work demonstrates a high level of achievement of curriculum expectations; strong understanding of required knowledge and skills; applies these to new situations
- AA refers to *Appropriate Achievement* ~ work demonstrates an acceptable level of achievement of curriculum expectations; basic to good understanding of required knowledge and skills; applies these to some new situations
- BAA refers to *Below Appropriate Achievement* ~ achievement of curriculum expectations tends to be limited or below what is typically demonstrated by students at this age/grade level; additional instructional support and improvement needed to meet required knowledge and skills
- We would ask that you take some time to review the contents and when finished, please sign the envelope where indicated and return only the envelope to school (the report card is yours to keep)
