Assessment Duotangs

Assessment duotangs will be coming home again this week. Please take some time to look through your child's assessments. Here are a couple of things to consider when looking at your child's work:

- In a couple of areas (counting and letters) you will notice that your child was assessed for a second time on the same content. When we do this we are looking for evidence that students have retained the information they have learned. If you see that your child no longer knows certain letters or is now having trouble counting backwards, it would be a good idea to reinforce these areas at home and we will continue to work on them at school as well.
- At the time of this assessment, our students had been taught 12 letters and sounds. If you're noticing that your child is missing some letters or sounds, we recommend spending a bit of extra time on these at home for added practice. In the new year, our students will be beginning to use these letters and sounds to read and write. The more confident they are with these letters and sounds, the more successful they'll likely be in their journey to becoming readers and writers.
